YACHT TENDER

The Madelon is a classic design originally built by The Geo. F. Lawley & Sons of Neponset, Mass. I purchased the plans from Mystic Seaport Museum in Mystic, Conn and lofted the plans to full size. Then I adapted the plans to be constructed with modern lower maintenance materials.

The hull is constructed with edge glued book matched western red cedar, sealed, reinforced, and protected inside and out with 6 oz. fiberglass cloth saturated with epoxy resin. The transom is made of marine plywood. This is over coated with UV resistant marine varnish. The trim is white ash; thwarts are red cedar reinforced with fiberglass and epoxy. The thwarts are supported on center with traditional hand turned white ash posts.

All hardware is marine bronze. The boat comes with oars fitted with round oarlocks retained with hand woven turkshead bindings.
